Minutes SARA Meeting November 3rd 2023

Meeting called to order by Kenny KB9KC at 7:00PM with introductions by 16 members present.

Secretary Report: Motion made by Buddy K9JBA and seconded by Darrell N9JOD to accept the report as printed in the SARA Slip. Motion passed

Treasurer Report: Motion made by Buddy K9JBA and seconded by Darrell N9JOD to accept the treasurer's report as printed in the SARA Slip. Motion passed

Repeater Committee Report: Leroy KB9JNO reported that the 147.090/146.880 SARA/SCAN repeater had been checked and reset some control codes and was working ok as of meeting time. The system seemed to doing ok as well.

Skywarn Report: KB9KC had no severe weather reports and reminded everyone that winter storm training will be coming up soon, with one taking place on Wednesday November 8th at The Pavilion in Marion from 9:00AM to 12:00PM. Announcements: Shawn K9PWW will be doing a Ham Radio demonstration in the evening of November 8th for the Science-Technology-Engineeering and Mathmatics at Herrin Elementry School running FT-8 on H.F. And 2 meter phone contacts.

Bruce WA9APQ spoke about an upcoming meeting on Tuesday, November 7th at the Veterans Airport west of Marion that will focus on the radio communications capabilities of the StarCom system

ARRL: Tom W9RY encouraged all present to comment on the FCC's 60 meter band proposal as the comment period has been extended to the end of November. Tom also stated that the

will be an Illinois ARRL convention next year in September at Peoria. Tom spoke about HF interference being caused by financial companies sending data in the northwest suburbs of Chicago that runs about every thirty minutes with a 20KW power level signal that is 30KC's in band width. Tom spoke also about a U.S. Government project to study RF propagation using a 4KW transmitter power from 0-25MHz that is causing problems as well on the HF bands. It keys up at 10 minute intervals and is 30KC band width.

Old Business: Bob N9VKO thanked all volunteers that braved the rainy/breezy weather to provide communications support for The Pinckneyville Mardi-Gras nightime parade on Saturday October 28th.
