MINUTES

SARA Meeting Minutes May 5th 2023

Meeting called to order by Kenny KB9KC at 7:00PM with 15 members

Secretary Report : Motion made by Dan KC9CVN and seconded by Gerry WG9Z to accept the minutes of the last meeting as printed in The SARA Slip. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Motion made by Fred AA9FS and seconded by Red KC9YKM to accept the treasurer's report as printed in the SARA Slip. Motion passed.

Repeater Committee Report: Bruce WA9APQ stated that the 146.640 repeater was working well but not hearing much use of it. WBOVTM Jon now has ECHOLINK up and running on the repeater. Bruce also stated that the 147.090 repeater is doing ok and reminded everyone to allow 1 ½ – 2 seconds after keying the microphone before speaking due to the delays in the link system to the 146.880 SCAN repeater. If not used in that way it can be very difficult to copy your callsign. Bruce WA9APQ spoke about repeater back up power batteries. Two group 27 deep cycle batteries have been used in the past with one blowing off the top in the past. Bruce also had experienced similar overheating issues with emergency equipment. N9VKO Bob explained that instead of group 27 batteries the MARA Club will be installing 2 – 230 amp/hr. 6 volt golf cart batteries in series rather than in 2 – 12 volt batteries in parallel connection. Bruce and Bob felt that it would greatly reduce the possibility of battery overheating and run the repeater for longer periods in the event of a commercial power outage.

Skywarn Report: Kenny KB9KC reminded everyone to be aware of weather conditions as they can change rapidly at this time of year.

Old Business: Bob N9VKO stated that everything went pretty well at the River To River Relay this year. Bob stated that some sizes of 5 year volunteer jackets were on order as well as some other items for other years of volunteering. A donation of \$125.00 from The River to River Runners was given to the Treasurer Richard KC9OLJ as a thank you for the use of the 147.090/146.880 linked repeater system. Bob N9VKO also noted that donations will also be given to the MARA Club, SCAN Club and the W9WG 147.345 Tunnel Hill repeater clubs as a thank you and to help with repeater maintenance.

Kenny KB9KC reminded everyone that the once again communications support has been requested for the Shawnee Hills 100

Race to be held on August 26-27 with the same race course being used. N9VKO Bob Stated that he will be taking a more active role in organizing the communications team. New Business : Tom W9RY spoke about the ARRL survey referring to the possibility of raise member dues as well as other issues. Tom stressed the importance of logging in to the ARRL and filling out the survey
