SARA Meeting Minutes May 2nd 2025

Meeting called to order by Kenny KB9KC at 7:00PM with 20 members

Repeater Committee Report: Bruce WA9APQ reported that the 147.090 repeater has weak signal at his home station with Leroy KB9JNO reporting the same weak signal. They indicated that they would be checking out antennas and coaxes in the near future.

Skywarn Report: Kenny KB9KC thanked Thom W9RY for taking care of net control duties on the 146.880/147.090 linked repeaters during recent severe weather events and there were several comments from others present about the rainy season we are experiencing.

Old Business: Bob N9VKO stated that everything went pretty well at the River To River Relay this year. There was some discussion about needing more help to control traffic on the Eddyville Road as it is an important route for emergency vehicles in Pope County and there was once again problems with free flow of traffic and safety of the runners and teammates at stages 22 and especially stage 23.
